## CIVIL DEFENCE CORPS UNIFORM.

The battledress blouse will be worn fastened at the neck unless worn with a white shirt and collar and a black tie provided by the individual member.

For organised parades, the correct footwear for men will be black boots or shoes.

### Badges and Markings.

#### (a) Breast Badge.

The breast badge will consist of a Civil Defence Corps Badge embroidered in gold thread.

The badge will be sewn on the left breast pocket, centred between the two sides, the top of the badge level with the centre point of the flap of the pocket.

#### (b) Cap Badge.

A badge of the same size and design as the breast badge will be worn on the beret. The beret will be worn with the flat tilted to the right side and the badge should be on the left side above the eye.

#### (c) Shoulder Titles.

The title of the Section of the Corps to which the member belongs will be worn (in the form of an arc of lettering woven in gold thread) on each sleeve  $\frac{1}{4}$ " below the shoulder seam. Sub-Sectional titles, when decided, will take the form of a line of lettering woven in gold thread and will be worn immediately below the title of the Section.

#### (d) Divisional Markings.

The name of the Corps Authority to whose Division the member belongs will be worn (in the form of an arc of lettering woven in gold thread) immediately below the breast badge.

#### (e) Medal Ribbons.

Medal ribbons will be worn above the flap of the left breast pocket.

#### (f) Instructors' Badges.

To be worn on the right forearm of the greatcoat and Battledress blouse, 4" above the cuff seam.

N.B. The uniform is intended to be worn only for the purposes of the Civil Defence Corps, i.e. on organised parades, demonstrations etc., or while undergoing or proceeding to and from training. Where training is liable to cause damage to uniforms, they should be protected by overalls.
